

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Policy

The Medical Board of Australia requires all medical practitioners who are engaged in any form of practice to participate regularly in continuing medical education (CME) that is relevant to their scope of practice in order to maintain, develop and enhance their knowledge skills and performance and so ensure that they deliver appropriate and safe care. The College has developed a program which meets the Medical Board requirements but also meets the requirements of the College to retain membership level within the College. All members are required to submit evidence of CME/CPD to the College annually to comply with this requirement.
