Current April 2025

The Medical Board of Australia requires all medical practitioners who are engaged in any form of practice to participate regularly in continuing medical education (CME) that is relevant to their scope of practice in order to maintain, develop and enhance their knowledge skills and performance and so ensure that they deliver appropriate and safe care.
